The proposal has been forwarded to members of the FoT Project Proposal Review Board. They will determine whether or not FoT should fund this project at the close of the current quarter, which ends on September 30.

The proposal was written and submitted by **Anita Alcorn of Thai 114** and Lampang on behalf of her colleagues with the PHA Network Committee of Lampang. It represents a truly remarkable grassroots effort to deal with a very serious health and societal problem, one with which an increasing number of PCVs in Thailand have become involved.
